## Annual Float Trip down the Shenandoah

Time Again for our float trip! Get ready, patch those inner tubes and break out your tents!

**Date:** June 21-23, 2024

**Location:** Low Water Bridge Campground  
192 Panhandle Rd., Bentonville, Va. 22610

**Directions:** I-66 west to exit 340 South, Bentonville exit, then right on Indian Hollow Rd., after you go through Bentonville. Check-in to the site can be anytime after 2pm. Check-in at the office and they will direct you to the campsites and there will be Fagowee staff at the site to help. Check-out is 12 Noon.

This will be primitive camping, so you must provide all your own equipment. We will have 5 electrical sites, so power can be provided.

**Cost:** Adults \$75.00 (16 and up)

**Children** \$30.00 (7 to 15) / Free (6 & Under)

**Meals Included:** Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, Saturday dinner, and Sunday breakfast. Happy hour will be held 3 to 6pm Fri. and Sat., with beer, wine, soda and snacks.

**Sign Up** at DCFagowees website for the Camping portion. Tubing on the river is at your own discretion and expense. Bring your floats and you can put in to the river right at the campground.

**Floats & transportation services are available** through the campground office. Tube Rental is \$10, Transportation to put-in upstream or pick-up downstream is \$15 one way. Beer Cooler Float \$10 rent.

Kayaks and Canoes can be rented from Down River Company next door to the campground.

## Ocean City Beach Week

### Castle in the Sand Hotel - September 16 – 23, 2024

Come join us for a week of beach fun at Ocean City. Castle in the Sand is located on the beach at 37<sup>th</sup> street; easy walking distance to the boardwalk. On the grounds is the **Coco-nuts Beach Bar and Grill**, one of the most popular bars in OC and the only establishment in OC where you are allowed to bring your drinks to the beach. Coconuts will be open with live entertainment from 11am to 11pm daily. The property also includes an on-site breakfast restaurant and an Olympic size pool.

**ACCOMODATIONS** - All units are oceanfront efficiencies in the Waverly building (as previous years). We have blocked all 10 units on the ground floor (which opens directly to the beach behind the dunes) as well as several upper floor efficiencies with balconies. If you want a clear view of the beach over the dunes, be sure to ask for 3<sup>rd</sup> floor or above. All units are identical and have two queen beds, a pull-out sofa, and a small kitchen area (including refrigerator, oven, and microwave). We also have access to a large interior party room on the lower level. Waverly is located directly on the beach adjacent to Coconuts, and has curbside access for loading/unloading, elevators, and vending machines on each level. Free private parking is provided.

**LODGING** – **Lodging** prices are on a **per efficiency** basis. There is no up-charge for additional people per room. Pick your roommates, pick your dates, and have one person call the hotel. Just be sure to indicate your preference for ground level vs. upper level when you make your reservations.

**PARTY FEE:** \$25 **per person paid to the Fagowees** via on-line registration at DCFagowees.com.

**NON-MEMBER GUEST FEE:** \$35 **per person** (\$25 party + \$10 non-member fee)

**BEACH PARTY** – We have a beach party starting at 3:00pm on Saturday. Party food and drinks (wine, beer, soda) will be provided. In case of rain, party will be held in the Waverly party room.

**PAYMENTS & CANCELLATIONS:** To guarantee availability, make your reservations no later than August 19<sup>th</sup>. A deposit equal to the first day's rent is due to the hotel at sign-up. To make a hotel reservation, contact Patricia Smith ([groups@castleinthesand.com](mailto:groups@castleinthesand.com); 410-289-6846), tell her you're with the Fagowee group, and reserve your room. (Payments are refundable if you cancel at least two weeks prior to arrival date.) Then, have each person in your group register on the Fagowee website and pay the party fee.
