

Horse Trail Ride—Sunday, Oct 28—Marriot Ranch

Hello, it's time to Save the Date for the annual fall horse trail ride!! Do you like experiencing nature in the foothills of the Blue Ridge mountains? How about experiencing it from the back of a horse riding through tranquil fields and forests? If so, please join us on Saturday October 28, 2023, at the Marriott Ranch where you can participate in a scenic trail ride with the Fagowees!

All riders must be 10 years of age or older and weigh no more than 220 pounds. The ranch provides horses for the ride from its trail barn located at **4439 Fiery Run Road, Linden, VA**. The beauty of this activity is that you do not need to know how to ride a horse, just how to follow directions about mounting, steering, riding and dismounting your horse that will be provided before you set off on your 1-hour scenic ride.

If we have a group of at least 6 people, the cost is \$75 per person (\$80 per person if our group is less than 6 peo-

Dates are flexible for early arrival or late departure. Let Siegi Tours present us with a fun week for skiers and non-skiers alike. In addition to comprehensive ski packages covering 6 interconnected ski resorts in the Salzburger Sportwelt, there is plenty for non-skiers to see and do. Examples include tobogganing, snow tubing, Nordic skiing, taking an evening sleigh ride, exploring the wonderful music city of Salzburg, taking the Sound of Music tour, exploring the salt mines, seeing the Eagles Nest in Bavaria, visiting an Alpine spa, or just going into the nearby village of St. Johann to shop, stroll, and have a cuppa cuppa at a cafe.

Participants will arrange their personalized packages directly with Siegi Tours as well as arrange transportation to the resort. St. Veit im Pongau is easily reached by train from Munich or Salzburg. Ocean City Beach Week

Castle in the Sand Hotel - September 18 - 25

For two years running, this has proven to be a winner. It's a great venue with a fantastic staff. Castle in the Sand is located on the beach at 37th street; easy walking distance to the boardwalk. On the grounds is the **Coconuts Beach Bar and Grill**, one of the most popular bars in OC and the only establishment in OC where you are allowed to bring your drinks to the beach.* Coconuts will be open with live entertainment from 11am to 11pm daily. The property also includes an onsite breakfast restaurant and an Olympic size pool.

ACCOMODATIONS - All units are oceanfront efficiencies in the Waverly building (as previous

years). We have blocked 9 units on the ground floor (which opens directly to the beach behind the dunes) as well as several upper floor efficiencies with balconies. If you want a clear view of the beach over the dunes, be sure to ask for 3rd floor or above. All units are identical and have two queen beds, a pull-out sofa, and a small kitchen area (including refrigerator, oven, and microwave). We also have access to a large interior party room on the lower level. Waverly is located directly on the beach adjacent to Coconuts,



and has curbside access for loading/unloading, elevators, and vending machines on each level. Free private parking is provided.

LODGING – **Lodging** prices are on a **per efficiency** basis. There is no up-charge for additional people per room. So, determine how many you want to have in your room, pick your roommates, pick your dates, and have one person call the hotel. Just be sure to indicate your preference for ground level vs. upper level when you make your reservations.

Full Week: Monday, Sept 18 – Monday, Sept 25: \$1213.23 per efficiency (tax included) Weekend Only: Friday, Sept 22 – Sunday, Sept 24: \$608.28 per efficiency (tax included) Extended Weekend: Friday, Sept 22 – Monday, Sept 25: \$729.27 per efficiency (tax included) Weekdays Only: Monday, Sept 18 – Friday, Sept 22: \$483.96 per efficiency (tax included)

BEACH PARTY – We have a beach party starting at 3:00pm on Saturday. Party food and drinks (wine, beer, soda) will be provided.

PARTY FEE: \$25 per person paid to the Fagowees via on-line registration.

PAYMENTS & CANCELLATIONS: To make a hotel reservation, contact Patricia Smith (groups@castleinthesand.com; 410-289-6846), tell her you're with the Fagowee group, and reserve your room. Then, have each in your group register on the Fagowee website to pay the party fee.

RESERVATIONS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN SEPT 4. A deposit EQUAL to the first day's

rent is due to the hotel at sign-up. Payments are refundable if you cancel at least two weeks prior to arrival date.
