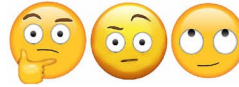

Ocean City Beach Week

Castle in the Sand Hotel - September 18 – 25

For two years running, this has proven to be a winner. It's a great venue with a fantastic staff. Castle in the Sand is located on the beach at 37th street; easy walking distance to the boardwalk. On the grounds is the **Coconuts Beach Bar and Grill**, one of the most popular bars in OC and the only establishment in OC where you are allowed to bring your drinks to the beach.* Coconuts will be open with live entertainment from 11am to 11pm daily. The property also includes an onsite breakfast restaurant and an Olympic size pool.

ACCOMODATIONS - All units are oceanfront efficiencies in the Waverly building (as previous years). We have blocked 9 units on the ground floor (which opens directly to the beach behind the dunes) as well as several upper floor efficiencies with balconies. If you want a clear view of the beach over the dunes, be sure to ask for 3rd floor or above. All units are identical and have two queen beds, a pull-out sofa, and a small kitchen area (including refrigerator, oven, and microwave). We also have access to a large interior party room on the lower level. Waverly is located directly on the beach adjacent to Coconuts, and has curbside access for loading/unloading, elevators, and vending machines on each level. Free private parking is provided.



LODGING – Lodging prices are on a **per efficiency** basis. There is no up-charge for additional people per room. So, determine how many you want to have in your room, pick your roommates, pick your dates, and have one person call the hotel. Just be sure to indicate your preference for ground level vs. upper level when you make your reservations.

LODGING DATES AND RATES – Paid directly to the hotel

Full Week: Monday, Sept 18 – Monday, Sept 25: \$1213.23 **per efficiency (tax included)**

Weekend Only: Friday, Sept 22 – Sunday, Sept 24: \$608.28 **per efficiency (tax included)**

Extended Weekend: Friday, Sept 22 – Monday, Sept 25: \$729.27 **per efficiency (tax included)**

Weekdays Only: Monday, Sept 18 – Friday, Sept 22: \$483.96 **per efficiency (tax included)**

BEACH PARTY – We have a beach party starting at 3:00pm on Saturday. Party food and drinks (wine, beer, soda) will be provided.

PARTY FEE: \$25 **per person paid to the Fagowees** via on-line registration.

PAYMENTS & CANCELLATIONS: To make a hotel reservation, contact Patricia Smith (groups@castleinthesand.com; 410-289-6846), tell her you're with the Fagowee group, and reserve your room. Then, have each in your group register on the Fagowee website to pay the party fee.

RESERVATIONS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN SEPT 4. A deposit EQUAL to the first day's rent is due to the hotel at sign-up. Payments are refundable if you cancel at least two weeks prior to arrival date.

Oh yes, Oh yes, a return to the good times enjoying the camaraderie, the outdoors, the waters of the Shenandoah River and camping with the Fagowees! The annual float trip is on at a new location. Per their website, amenities include showers & restrooms, camp store and a gift shop. Civilization is not too far away if you need something. Off site nearby, you'll find hiking trails, no doubt a few wineries and Skyline Drive & Skyline Caverns.

Date: June 9-11, 2023, **Check in time:** 12 Noon

Location: **LOW WATER BRIDGE CAMPGROUND**

192 Panhandle Road, Bentonville, Va. 22610

Directions: I-66 West to Exit 6 Rt. 340 South to Front Royal and Bentonville OR I-66 West to Exit 13 (Linden & Shenandoah National Park) then right on 55 to Front Royal and left on Rt 340 South to Bentonville. Go through Bentonville and turn right on Indian Hollow Rd. (aka Rt 613) and that will take you to the campground. GPS is also good.

This will be primitive camping so bring your own camping equipment and support gear. The sites we have reserved will accommodate several tents plus vehicles. Overflow parking is available just in case. There are very limited electrical outlets available, so if you have specific medical needs or questions, contact John Morrison asap. None of the sites have water, but water stations are available for portage of water. Additionally a compressor is available for use just outside the office. Generators are not allowed. Pets are allowed as long as they are contained, anchored or on a leash. If you anticipate bringing an RV, please let John know asap.

Cost: \$80.00 for adults 21 and up
\$55.00 for 20 and under
Children under 7 are free.

Deadline for payment is May 27 2023

Tubing is available from the campsite and there is a pick-up and return charge. Kayaks and canoes can be rented from Down River Canoe Company, which is right across the river from the campground. You should pass it as you make your way to the campground. Their website is DownRiver.com.

Meals Included: Friday Dinner, Saturday Breakfast and Dinner, Sunday Breakfast. In addition the club will host **Happy Hour** from 4pm to 6pm Friday and Saturday with Beer, wine, soda, and light snacks.

HELP, ETC: This trip definitely takes a village. We will need volunteers to help set up Friday, assist with check-in and the campsites, cook, clean up, and tear down on Sunday. We may also need volunteers to help transport equipment to/from the campground.

Not all of our sites are the same size, so in order to help in allocating tent space, please let John know the size of your tents and how many people are in your party.
